

COMPLETE COUNTY MAP FOR ANSON

The State Superintendent of Public Instruction called the attention of a Post writer yesterday to a gratifying "first fruits" of the recent conference of the county superintendents here. It was the announcement in a Wadesboro paper that the county board of education and the county commissioners had arranged to have a complete map of the county made, showing all roads, public places, streams, etc., and detail. Three-fourths of the expense of the map is to be borne by the county board of education and the remaining one-fourth will be paid by the county commissioners. The paper states that the map will cost \$900. This, the paper contended, was an exorbitant price, but congratulated the county on getting the map, a copy of which will be placed in every school house in the county.
